Section 19 INITIATION FEES, DUES & ASSESSMENTS

Upon receipt by the Secretary Treasurer of application for membership into the Local, every individual candidate shall remit the sum of five dollars (\$5.00) initiation fee; such amount shall be collected by the Secretary Treasurer and a receipt shall be given in every case.
